1. Situation. The purpose of this Bulletin is to announce the Annual Eastern Division Match Rifle and Pistol Competition for CY 2016. The Bulletin also provides initial planning guidance in support of the CY 2016 Marine Corps Championship Program in accordance with the references. The Eastern Division Match Rifle and Pistol Competition are designed to improve the marksmanship skills of all Marine Corps Installations on the East Coast. The Eastern Division Match is open to all Marines stationed in the continental United States east of the Mississippi River. There is no limit on the number of competitors a command may send however the maximum number for the competition is 276. Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ) will host the matches for all commands.

2. Mission. From 18 March 2016 to 1 April 2016 ensure that all eligible units are aware of the opportunity to have their Marines improve their marksmanship skills by competing in Eastern Division Match (EDM) and Marine Corps Match (MCM) to promote and stimulate interest in the Marine Corps CIAP.

3. Execution

a. Commanding General's Intent. To have as many units as possible participate in a competitive combat marksmanship environment where every Marine will increase their marksmanship proficiency. This will broaden the synergistic relationship between Weapons Training Battalion (WTBN) and the units in the Camp Lejeune geographical area which it supports and promote our ethos of "Every Marine a Rifleman".

b. Concept of Operations

(1) The CY 2016 CIAP will be conducted at WTBN per reference (c). The EDM will be conducted from 21 March 2016 to 1 April 2016. The MCM will

be conducted from 4 to 22 April 2016. Additional guidance for this event will be published via separate correspondence.

(2) EDM schedule is provided in enclosure (1). On 9 March 2016, a meeting for all team captains from respective units will be conducted at WTBN in RR-11 at 1300. This meeting will cover administrative requirements, check-in procedures, billeting, and messing. Team captains will turn in all detailed rosters and meal requests to Match Stats and make billeting arrangements with WTBN Billeting located in RR-4. All team captains not located in the CAMLEJ/New River/Cherry Point area will not be required to attend the team captain's meeting, but will make prior coordination via email and telephone to state intent to compete and turn in all required paperwork no later than 1300 on 9 March 2016.

(3) On 18 March 2016, the in-brief and check-in for all competitors, coaches, and captains will go at 0800 in the WTBN Gym (RR-8). All personnel must attend this brief and check in. After the brief, all weapons will be turned into the WTBN Armory.

(4) Format for the rifle and pistol competition will be the Division Match course of fire per enclosure (1) and (2).

c. Tasks

(1) MCIEAST and MCB CAMLEJ Commands. Ensure team captains attend the meeting in building RR-11 at 1300 on 9 March 2016. All MCB CAMLEJ units are highly encouraged to submit at least one team per paragraph 3b. Those units not located on CAMLEJ, New River, or Cherry Point are not required to attend the team captain's meeting; however, WTBN requires that these units contact WTBN telephonically and via e-mail with their intent to attend the EDM.

(2) Tenant Commands. All Marine Corps active duty and reserve tenant commands are invited to participate in the EDM program. All team captains from II Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF), 2d Marine Division (MarDiv), 2d Marine Logistics Group (MLG), 2d Marine Air Wing (MAW), Training and Education Command (TECOM) Schools, and U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Special Operations Command (MARSOC) are required to attend the meetings in building RR-11 at 1300 on 9 March 2016.

(3) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ, Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), G-3/5. Provide photographic support for historical purposes and graphic support for preparation of match welcome aboard packages and awards ceremony programs.

(4) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ, AC/S, G-1. Ensure all required Fleet Assistance Program (FAP) personnel, as delineated in Enclosure (2) of reference (e), arrive at WTBN as designated.

(5) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ, AC/S, G-4. Provide 25 tables and 350 chairs in support of EDM and MCM, 17 March to 22 April 2016.

(6) Commanding Officer, WTBN

(a) Arrange messing and provide billeting to all competitors as needed.

(b) Provide additional support, as necessary, to conduct the competition.

(c) Reserve the Stone Bay Gymnasium for match briefings, classes, and ceremonies on the dates listed below:

1. EDM: 21 March 2016; 31 March - 1 April 2016.

2. MCM: 4 - 5 April 2016; 21 - 22 April 2016.

(7) Director, Public Affairs Office

(a) Provide public affairs support for the CY 2016 EDM and MCM include advance notification of the event using electronic and print media.

(b) Provide public affairs support for Commanding General (CG), MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ presentation of awards and trophies for the EDM on 1 April 2016.

(c) Coordinate with Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps, Public Affairs Division, for public affairs support of presentation of awards and trophies for the MCM on 22 April 2016.

d. Coordinating Instructions

(1) All units assigned MCIEAST and MCB CAMLEJ are eligible to enter into this competition. Commanding officers/officers-in-charge of units eligible to participate are requested to enter competitors per the following criteria:

(a) All units are encouraged to send as many individuals to the competition as possible. The WTBN S-3 will limit the number of competitors per unit if the total match number exceeds 276.

(b) Personnel on Temporary Additional Duty (TAD) or assigned by FAP are authorized to compete with their joining unit.

(2) Teams will be organized as follows:

(a) Minimum of four shooting members per team.

(b) One firing officer (no longer waiverable); one Marine who has never shot in a division level competition (known as a "tyro", any rank allowed); two Marines of any rank, one of which must be enlisted; one team captain and one team coach, team captain and/or coach requirement may be filled by one of the firing members.

(c) No more than two firing members may be distinguished marksman for the rifle team match and no more than two firing members may be distinguished pistol shots for the team pistol match.

(3) Authorized weapons for EDM are the M16A4 service rifle or the M4 carbine with RCO and the M9 service pistol.

(4) All competitors in EDM are required to compete with both rifle and pistol, and to attend all instruction and training listed in enclosure (1) of this Bulletin.

(5) Civilian competitors are authorized, at the discretion of the CG MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ to participate in EDM but must complete all required training. They must also fire the same service weapons as the active duty/reserve competitors. Civilian competitors are not authorized to compete in MCM.

(6) During the first week of EDM, team captains will be designated to fire for the large or small unit trophy based on unit size. Guidance for making this determination is contained in reference (b). If fewer than three eligible teams are present, the small unit trophy will not be contested.

4. Administration and Logistics

a. Awards. Awards will be given based on those Marines who place in the top 10 percent of EDM. Civilian competitors may receive distinguished credit points, but are not eligible for any further awards to include team awards. The exception to this rule is retired Marines will receive a distinguished badge if they earn their final points at EDM.

b. Marines who place in the top 10 percent at EDM may participate in MCM at the discretion of their command. These participants will be provided TAD funding by the Marine Corps Shooting Team if they are not tenant units located in and around MCB CAMLEJ.

c. Logistics

(1) Billeting will be available at WTBN with WTBN Billeting at (910) 440-2651 or (910) 358-0793 in Building RR-4.

(2) Team Captains will turn in all detailed rosters, and meal requests to the S-3 at (910) 440-1600.

(3) All necessary shooting equipment is listed in enclosure (3). Standard competition equipment will be utilized for all training and competition. Limited amounts are available for issue through WTBN Supply.

(4) Pre-Fire Inspections (PFIs) and Limited Technical Inspections (LTIs) for all weapons must be 100 percent accurate, completed and documentation submitted when weapons are turned into the WTBN Armory on 18 March 2016.

(5) The format for all rosters will be the routine WTBN annual requalification formats, examples of which can be found on the S-3 tab of the WTBN web site or share point site:


