subj: ACTIVATION OF ONSLOW BEACH DETACHMENT AND OPERATION OF ONSLOW BEACH

RECREATION AREA FOR THE 2013 SUMMER SEASON

Encl: (1) Beach Detachment Personnel Requirements

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To announce the seasonal personnel requirements as outlined in reference (a) and enclosure (1), of the Onslow Beach Detachment and to provide necessary equipment and materials for its annual activation.

#### 2. Action

- a. Personnel assigned to the 2013 Onslow Beach detachment will be directed to report to the Commanding General (CG), Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ), Building 1, Room 236 for appropriate screening and further endorsement. Personnel designated in enclosure (1) must report with Fleet Assistance Program (FAP) orders issued by II Marine Expeditionary Force (G-1).
- b. The staff noncommissioned officer in charge (SNCOIC), line number 001 and the assistant SNCOIC, line number 002, and lifeguard, line number 003 will be activated no later than 1600 on Monday, 18 March 2013. The lifeguards and police, line numbers 004 to 024 for the Onslow Beach Detachment will be activated no later than 1600 on Monday, 25 March 2013, to begin the two month open water lifeguard training. Personnel who do not qualify to serve as lifeguards will be utilized as beach detachment police.
- c. Monday, 27 May 2013, through Monday, 2 September 2013, the swimming areas of Onslow Beach recreation area will be open for all authorized patrons.
- d. In the event of destructive weather the beach area may be closed by order of the CG MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ.

### e. Tasks

(1) Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), G-1 shall: Complete staffing of the Onslow Beach detachment, per this Bulletin and the reference, by Wednesday, 1 May 2013. Provide the SNCOIC, assistant SNCOIC, and NCOIC by 18 March. Provide the main body of 21 lifeguards and police call personnel by

25 March 2013 and the remaining eight police call personnel by 1 May 2013, to ensure training is accomplished prior to opening of the beach. Beach Detachment personnel must meet the following requirements:

- (a) Expiration of active service date 1 January 2014. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- (b) Assignment and screening requirements for FAP augments are outlined in the reference and must be strictly observed.
- (c) Lifeguards must pass tests requiring them to swim 500 yards in 12 minutes and lifeguard certification. It is strongly recommended nominees possess a Water Survival-Intermediate qualification or better to complete the life guard certification. It is imperative that all nominees possess strong leadership skills. Situations arise at the beach that can be life threatening and require immediate action and appropriate judgment.
- (d) Pass appropriate basic first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation instructional courses offered by Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS) personnel.
- (2) AC/S, Security and Emergency Services shall: Provide necessary ambulance support to Onslow Beach and routine law enforcement support.
- (3) AC/S, MCCS shall: Assume operational control of the Onslow Beach detachment and recreation area to include:
  - (a) Supervision and policing of assigned areas.
  - (b) Security of the recreational beaches within capabilities.
- (c) Publication and enforcement of safety regulations pertaining to swimming, surfing, fishing, and organized recreation parties.
- (d) Acquire and provide necessary equipment for the operation of the beaches.
  - (e) Provide training of lifeguards.
- (4) Commanding Officer, Headquarters and Support Battalion shall: Annually, assume administrative control, provide health record custody and medical support of personnel, and provide billeting for Onslow Beach detachment, per the reference.
- (5) <u>Director</u>, <u>Public Affairs Office shall</u>: <u>Publish the opening of Onslow Beach and the bus operating schedules</u>.
- 3. <u>Reserve Applicability</u>. This Bulletin is applicable to Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and its tenant organizations.

- 2. No grade substitution authorized because of leadership requirements.
- 3. Must possess current lifeguard course certificate prior to opening of beach.
- 4. Incumbent will remain after Onslow Beach is closed in order to ensure clean up and to secure all gear. Termination is to be approximately the end of September.
