Subj: MCICOM AUDIT PREPARATION POLICY - AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL  
(ATC) ASSET ACCOUNTABILITY

1. Purpose. To publish policy regarding asset accountability of air traffic control assets.
2. Discussion. The Marine Corps has not yet made an official determination regarding the accountability of air traffic control simulation assets for the purpose of audit coordination and response.
3. Policy. Marine Corps Installations Command (MCICOM) is not responsible for the asset accountability of air traffic control simulation assets and will not assert to the audit readiness of air traffic control simulation assets.
4. Action. This policy is in effect until amended or rescinded.
5. Applicability. This policy applies to both MCICOM and Training and Education Command (TECOM) commanded installations.
