

Subj: MCICOM AUDIT PREPARATION POLICY - AVIATION SIMULATION  
ASSET ACCOUNTABILITY

1. Purpose. To publish policy regarding asset accountability of aircraft simulators.
2. Discussion. The Marine Corps has not yet made an official determination regarding the accountability of aviation simulation assets for the purpose of audit coordination and response.
3. Policy. Unless otherwise directed, Marine Corps Installations Command (MCICOM) is not responsible for the asset accountability of aviation simulators and will not assert to the audit readiness of aviation simulation assets.
4. Action. This policy is in effect until amended or rescinded.
5. Applicability. This policy applies to both MCICOM and Training and Education Command (TECOM) commanded installations.
