Subj: GAMBLING, BETTING AND LOTTERIES

Ref: (a) MCO P1700.27A
(b) 18 U.S.C. 1955 (NOTAL)
(c) 18 U.S.C. 1382 (NOTAL)
(d) 18 U.S.C. 13 (NOTAL)

1. Situation. This Order promulgates regulations concerning gambling, lotteries, and games of chance, which are applicable to military and civilian personnel who live on, work on, or visit Camp Lejeune per reference (a).

2. Cancellation. BO 5370.7D.

3. Mission. To provide policy in regards to regulating any gambling activity.

a. Summary of Revision. This Order has been revised and should be thoroughly reviewed.

b. Punitive Effect. This Order is intended to be directive in nature and implemented immediately. Violations of this Order by military personnel are punishable pursuant to Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). A civilian who violates the provisions of this Order may be subject to prosecution per references (b) through (d).

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. To fully comply with this Order and its references.

(2) Concept of Operations. It is the policy of this Command to not allow any form of gambling aboard the Base.

b. Coordinating Instructions

(1) It is expressly prohibited for any person within the confines of Camp Lejeune to:

(a) Participate in any gambling activity (including the operation of a gambling device), conduct a lottery or a pool, participate in a game of chance for money or property, or sell or purchase a number slip or ticket unless such participation has been authorized by the Commanding Officer per reference (a).

(b) Originate or participate in "Pyramid Clubs," "Chain Letter Clubs," or similar activities.


(2) Addressees are requested to promulgate the contents of this Order to personnel within their commands and post on unit bulletin boards.

5. Administration and Logistics. This Order has been coordinated with and concurred by the Commanding Generals, II Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF), Marine Corps Installations East, 2d Marine Division, 2d Marine Logistics Group, II MEF Augmentation Command Element and Commanding Officers of Marine Corps Air Station, New River, the Naval Hospital, Navy Dental Center and the Special Missions Training Center, U.S. Coast Guard.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is effective the date signed.

b. Signal. This Order is applicable to the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune.
