Subj: OPEN SKIES (OS) TREATY IMPLEMENTATION

1. Situation. The OS Treaty is a security- and confidence-building measure that provides for unarmed aerial observation flights over the territory of signatory states by aerial platforms from other signatory states. The reference assigns responsibilities and issues guidance for Department of the Navy (DON) compliance and implementation of the treaty on OS. The Naval Treaty Implementation Program (NTIP) in Washington, DC is the DON executive agent for arms control implementation and the OS treaty. Upon notification, NTIP releases an OP-IMMEDIATE "General Alert - Open Skies Treaty Overflight" message to all Navy and Marine Corps commands in the OS Database, and each installation must acknowledge receipt directly to NTIP.

2. Cancellation. MCIEASTO 5510.1.

3. Mission. Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ) Installations will continue to respond directly to NTIP with required assessments and acknowledgements of receipt. A copy of all correspondence will be provided to MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G-3/5 or MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Command Duty Officer (CDO) after working hours.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent

(1) The establishment of MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ does not change the OS Treaty process. The NTIP will continue to release the General Alert Message directly to all Navy and Marine Corps installations and release subsequent messages to the affected installations. Likewise, Navy and Marine Corps Installations receiving the OS messages will continue to respond directly to the NTIP with required assessments and acknowledgements of receipt. The following guidance is provided for inclusion into OS Treaty Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for all MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations.

(a) The Office of Coordinating Responsibility (OCR) for all OS Treaty overflights is the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G-3/5 (Organizational Messaging Service (OMS) address "CG MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G3/5").

(b) All MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations will designate their Operations Department (O&P) or equivalent organization as the OCR for OS

Treaty events aboard their installation. Notifications must be passed to all local range airspace control agencies in order to provide impact assessments and ensure proper execution coordination.

(c) All OS Treaty flights within airspace controlled by MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ will be coordinated by the Operations and Plans Division under the cognizance of the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G-3/5.

(d) All MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations will have an after-hours notification and response SOP and/or desktop procedure that provide instructions for handling after-hours OS Treaty messages for their Communications Center, CDO, and Operations Department.

(e) The OMS address "CG MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G-3/5" will be included as an INFO/CC addressee for all official message correspondence between MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations and the NTIP. This will ensure MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ visibility of notifications, responses, and impact assessments while facilitating required airspace coordination. Responses made by e-mail, fax or phone will also be relayed to the G-3/5 or the CDO after working hours.

b. Concept of Operations. This Order should be used in conjunction with the reference and other current regulations and directives to ensure compliance with established policies, procedures, and higher headquarters. Deviations from procedures and instructions must be either approved by or referred to the Commanding General via the G-3/5.

5. Administration and Logistics


a. Administration. Enclosure (1) offers background information concerning OS Treaty messages. Enclosure (2) lists organizational points of contact used in the messaging process.

Open Skies Treaty Message Summary

Background. There are seven messages associated with each OS Treaty flight. Every OS message describes the response requirement in the text. Beginning at the General Alert, a unique observation identification number is assigned to every overflight. Generally, only affected installations within the swath of the overflight plan will receive messages 2-7.

1. General Alert
2. Proposed Flight Plan
3. Final Flight Plan
4. Stand Down
5. Fixed Radial Distance Message
6. Flight Update Notification
7. Flight Termination

As required by this Order, the "CG MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ G-3/5" will be added as an INFO/CC addressee for all correspondence between NTIP and MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations.
