COMMANDING GENERAL'S POLICY LETTER 001-11

Subj: MARINE CORPS INSTALLATIONS EAST (MCIEAST) POLICY FOR
INSTALLATION ACCESS OF SERVICE MEMBERS IN TAXICABS

1. Purpose. To establish policy and procedures for processing service members in taxicabs desiring access to Marine Corps Installations East installations.

2. Cancellation. CG Policy Letter 004-06.

3. Information

a. Service members desiring installation access who are passengers in taxicabs will be checked to ensure they have a valid Armed Forces Identification Card and are authorized to access the installation.

b. Being a passenger in a taxicab is NOT probable cause to check a service member for alcohol consumption.

4. Action

a. If a service member is detected of having consumed alcohol to the point of being incoherent, as determined by the supervisory Law Enforcement Officer on scene, and no other chargeable offense has been committed, Military Police/Marine Corps Law Enforcement will direct the service member to pay the cab driver, and then the service member will be taken to the Provost Marshal Office, where a unit representative will be called to pick up his or her service member(s). This Policy is strictly for the safety of the service member(s); therefore, a blotter entry will not be made.

b. If there is probable cause to check for alcohol consumption, such as disorderly conduct, injury, illness, etc., process the offense in accordance with Standard Operating Procedures.
