COMMANDING GENERAL'S POLICY LETTER 02-15

Subj: POLICY ON USE OF RECREATIONAL LODGING AT ONSLOW BEACH

Ref: (a) DoD Instruction 1015.10  
(b) MCO P1700.27B Ch 1

1. Purpose. In accordance with references (a) and (b), this policy establishes eligibility, procedures, and restrictions regarding the use of recreational lodging facilities at Onslow Beach.

2. Information. In order to accommodate the high demand for recreational lodging at Onslow Beach, the specific use priorities and procedures contained herein shall be followed.

3. Policy

a. The Protocol Officer, Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ), will manage the reservations process for the General Officers' Beach House (GOBH). Use of the GOBH is restricted to:

(1) Active duty, reserve, and retired Marine Corps General Officers.

(2) Active duty Flag Officers permanently assigned to Marine Corps Commands.

(3) Members of the Senior Executive Service assigned within the Marine Corps.

b. The Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS) Onslow Beach Office will manage the reservation process for all other recreational lodging facilities at Onslow Beach.

(1) Active duty military personnel stationed aboard MCB CAMLEJ; Marine Corps Air Station, New River (MCAS NR); and MCAS

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Cherry Point (CHERT) may reserve recreational lodging facilities at Onslow Beach up to 20 weeks prior to the reservation date.

(2) Active duty military personnel from all other duty stations, reservists, and retirees may reserve these facilities up to 18 weeks prior to the reservation date.

(3) Appropriated fund civilian employees, nonappropriated fund civilian employees, and educators employed by the Department of Defense Education Activity aboard MCB CAMLEJ, MCAS NR, or MCAS CHERT may reserve up to 16 weeks prior to the reservation date.

(4) The use of the O-6, O-5, and E-9 beach houses will be limited to use by those of that respective grade. Exceptions to this may be made by the Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), MCCS.

(5) In order to fully and fairly accommodate all eligible patrons, the MCCS Onslow Beach Office may implement additional procedures and restrictions as necessary.

#### 4. Action

a. AC/S, MCCS shall: Allow authorized patrons to reserve recreational lodging facilities at Onslow Beach according to reference (b) and this policy.

b. Protocol Officer, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ shall: Administer the reservations process for the GOBH.
