COMMANDING GENERAL'S POLICY LETTER 006-13

Subj: POLICY FOR MARINE CORPS COMMUNITY SERVICES (MCCS) PROGRAM
ADMINISTRATION

Ref: (a) MCO P1700.27B Ch 1
(b) Green Letter No. 09-98 (NOTAL)

1. Purpose. To reaffirm policy and procedures related to the delivery and administration of MCCS programs across Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ).

2. Cancellation. CG MCIEAST Policy letter 010-06.

3. Background

a. Among the primary responsibilities of installation commanders is their providing for the readiness, retention and well-being of our Marines and their families. Our installation-level MCCS programs are essential to the achievement and sustainment of individual and family readiness.

b. Reference (a), the MCCS Policy Manual, underscores the philosophy and intent first enunciated by our 29th Commandant in reference (b): "We have one Corps... we will have one standard approach in MCCS. Our Marines and families must be able to expect and receive the same level of access and availability to standardize support services and programs regardless of where they are stationed throughout the Corps. These programs require top down guidance and command engagement so we can ensure consistency across the Corps."

3. Policy


a. All installation commanders responsible for the MCCS programs aboard their installations shall establish procedures to promote the delivery of standardized MCCS programs, services, and pricing throughout the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ region.

Subj: POLICY FOR MARINE CORPS COMMUNITY SERVICES (MCCS) PROGRAM
ADMINISTRATION

The intent of the policy will be to meet the reasonable expectations of our Marines, their families, and other eligible patrons with regard to consistency and equity of MCCS programs throughout the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ region.

b. Close coordination, cooperation, and collaboration among installation commanders and MCCS Directors will be required to implement and sustain the policy objective of "sameness." While local circumstances, on occasion, may require exceptions to the rule, it is my intent that we will make a concerted, systematic effort to eliminate unnecessary differences, distinctions, and disparities in MCCS programs and pricing from one installation to the next.
