

# February 2016 Voting Assistance Officer To Do List

- **Super Bowl Challenge:** Host a voter registration drive or hang voting posters around your base Super Bowl Party. Post pictures to your installation Facebook account and tag us so we can share with others! PSAs, to show during the event, are available at <http://www.fvap.gov/info/outreach>.
- **Share Good Ideas:** The January 15<sup>th</sup> FPCA distribution requirement has passed. Share your good ideas and lessons learned up the chain or directly to FVAP. We are always looking for new ideas to improve awareness and participation in the absentee voting process.
- **Sign Up For Training:** Workshops are scheduled at 98 locations around the globe. Plan to attend one close to you or access the online training to be prepared for this election cycle. <http://www.fvap.gov/vao/training>.
- **Obtain Voting Materials:** Inventory and replenish your stock of voting materials that were consumed during the last elections. Posters, Voting Assistance Guides, trifold and forms, including the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA, SF-76), the Federal Write-in Absentee Voting Ballot (FWAB, SF-186), are available through your normal supply distribution channels. <http://www.fvap.gov/vao/training/materials>.
- **Prep for Primaries:** The first primary takes place February 6<sup>th</sup>. Ensure voters in your unit or installation are aware you are available to assist. Have FWABs on hand for those who do not receive their requested state ballot.
