01 November 2013 – 07 November 2013**

COMPLEX TRIAL TEAM

01 Nov 13

At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Corporal was acquitted by officer and enlisted members of aggravated sexual assault and abusive sexual contact.

05 Nov 13

US v. Brondeau:

At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Lance Corporal J. L. Brondeau was convicted by a military judge alone of attempt to commit a lewd act, possession of child pornography, and solicitation. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 years confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.

LSST – CAMP LEJEUNE

06 Nov 13

US v. Lovos:

At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Corporal R. A. Lovos, was convicted by officer and enlisted members of conspiracy to commit larceny, larceny, and a violation of Title 8 U.S.C. 1325(c): immigration fraud. The panel sentenced the accused to 15 months confinement, reduction to E-1 and a bad conduct discharge.

07 Nov 13

US v. Young Jr.:

At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Staff Sergeant R. J. Young Jr, was convicted by officer and enlisted members of violation of a lawful general order, wrongful sexual contact, and indecent exposure. The panel sentenced the accused to reduction to E-3, forfeiture of all pay and allowances and a bad conduct discharge.

LSST - CHERRY POINT

01 Nov 13

US v. Thai

At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Lance Corporal P. H. Thai was convicted by a military judge alone of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful possession of a controlled substance, and wrongful carrying a concealed weapon. The military judge sentenced the accused to 11 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.

05 Nov 13

US v. Boccia

At a Special Court-Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, a Corporal C. M. Boccia was convicted by a military judge alone of false official statement and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months confinement, reduction to E-1, a fine of \$10,000, and a bad conduct discharge.
