US v. Porter

At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Private S. M. Porter was convicted by a military judge alone of violating a lawful general order and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement and forfeiture of \$1,000.00 pay per month for 6 months.

**LSST - PARRIS ISLAND**

U.S. v. Dyas:

At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, a Staff Sergeant J. A. Dyas, was convicted by a military judge alone of assault consummated by a battery on a child under 16 years of age. The military judge sentenced the accused to 180 days of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct-discharge.

At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, a Staff Sergeant was acquitted by officer and enlisted members of violation of a general order and adultery.
