COMPLEX TRIAL TEAM

There were no cases disposed of for the week of 11 – 17 April 2014.

LSST – CAMP LEJEUNE

16 Apr 14

U.S. v. Chavira

At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Lance Corporal E. H. Chavira was convicted by a military judge alone of attempted wrongful use of a controlled substance, violation of a lawful general order, wrongful use of a controlled substance and wrongful introduction of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.

17 Apr 14

U.S. v. Gatlin

At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a Staff Sergeant G. E. Gatlin was convicted by a military judge alone of sodomy with a child under the age of 12, an indecent act, abusive sexual contact with a child, indecent liberties with a child, aggravated sexual assault of a child and sexual assault of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 years confinement, forfeiture of all pay, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.

LSST - PARRIS ISLAND

LSST - CHERRY POINT

At a General Court-Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, a Corporal was acquitted by officer and enlisted members of rape.
