GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. THE RESPONSIBLE USE OF ALCOHOL CAN BE PART OF MANY ENJOYABLE, SAFE EXPERIENCES IF USED IN MODERATION. HOWEVER, DRINKING ALCOHOL TO EXCESS CAN LEAD TO ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

A. FAILING TO FULFILL MAJOR WORK, SCHOOL, OR HOME RESPONSIBILITIES.
B. ENGAGING IN SITUATIONS THAT ARE PHYSICALLY DANGEROUS, SUCH AS WHILE DRIVING A CAR OR OPERATING MACHINERY.

C. BEING INVOLVED IN ALCOHOL-RELATED LEGAL PROBLEMS, SUCH AS BEING ARRESTED FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR FOR PHYSICALLY HURTING SOMEONE WHILE DRUNK.

D. HEALTH PROBLEMS, INCLUDING BRAIN DAMAGE, HEART DISEASE, FATTY LIVER, NERVOUS DISORDERS, CANCER, AND OTHER HEALTH PROBLEMS.
