GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. SINCE MARCH 2009, MCIEAST HAS CONDUCTED VOLUNTARY, STRUCTURED MOTORCYCLE TRACK DAY EVENTS, WHICH IS A ONE-DAY ADVANCED MOTORCYCLE TRAINING PROGRAM CONSISTING OF ALL ASPECTS OF SPEED AND DIRECTIONAL CHALLENGES, E.G., STEERING, BRAKING, THROTTLE CONTROL, AND LEAN ANGLE CONTROL. THE PURPOSE IS TO INCREASE THE RIDER'S AWARENESS OF THEIR MOTORCYCLE'S LIMITS AND THEIR PERSONAL LIMITS, ULTIMATELY INCREASING THEIR CONFIDENCE AND SAFETY.

2. MCIEAST HAS CONTRACTED WITH THE KEITH CODE CALIFORNIA SUPERBIKE SCHOOL (KCCSS) TO BRING AN INSTRUCTOR TO PROVIDE 12 ONE-DAY ARTD'S AT MCAS CHERRY POINT AND MCALF BOGUE FIELD, ALL OF WHICH IN THE PAST HAVE BEEN VERY SUCCESSFUL. ARTD'S CONTINUE TO GROW IN POPULARITY WITH DESIRES FROM MOTORCYCLE RIDERS FOR MORE ARTD'S WHICH WE HAVE

ANSWERED THIS YEAR, DOUBLING THE NUMBER OF SEATS AVAILABLE, OFFERING THE ARTD ON BOTH SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS.

3. PER REFS A, MCIEAST WILL HOST ARTD'S BEGINNING APRIL 2013 AT THE LOCATION SPECIFIED BELOW ON THE FOLLOWING DATES. THE TARGET AUDIENCE ARE MOTORCYCLE RIDERS (CRUISERS AND SPORTBIKES) OF ANY AGE FROM THE GREATER CHERRY POINT/CAMP LEJEUNE AREA.

A. APRIL 20&21-BOGUE FIELD

B. MAY 18&19-BOGUE FIELD

C. JUNE 22&23-CHERRY POINT

D. AUG 17&18-BOGUE FIELD

E. SEP 21&22-CHERRY POINT

F. OCT 19&20-CHERRY POINT

5. EACH ARTD WILL CONSIST OF MOTORCYCLE RIDERS DIVIDED INTO SESSIONS AND/OR GROUPS. RIDERS WILL BE GIVEN A COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY BRIEF AND THREE BASIC TECHNICAL POINTS TO WORK ON WHEN RIDING ON THE TRACK:

A.1. SETTING A PROPER ENTRY SPEED (NOT TOO SLOW OR FAST)

A.2. PROPER APPLICATION OF THROTTLE CONTROL IN A TURN

A.3. NOT APPLYING THROTTLE CONCURRENT WITH AN INCREASE OF LEAN ANGLE

B. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE SELECTED BASED UPON PRIOR COMPLETION OF REQUIRED AND FOLLOW-ON MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TRAINING, E.G., MOTORCYCLE SAFETY FOUNDATION (MSF) BASIC RIDERS COURSE (BRC), EXPERIENCED RIDERS COURSE (ERC), MILITARY SPORTBIKE RIDERS COURSE (MSRC), ETC.

C. PARTICIPANTS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN MOTORCYCLE, BE PART OF THEIR UNIT'S MOTORCYCLE MENTORSHIP PROGRAM, AND PROVIDE PROOF OF LICENSE, REGISTRATION, STATE INSPECTION, AND PROOF OF COMPLETION OF REQUIRED MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TRAINING.

D. SPECIFIC INFORMATION AND CALL FOR NOMINATIONS WILL BE RELEASED FOR EACH ARTD APPROXIMATELY 30 DAYS PRIOR TO EACH EVENT UNDER SEPCOR.
