SUBJECT: Determination of FY14 USMC Excepted Activities

- Sir, the Senior Level Working Group provides the following recommendations on the United States Marine Corps' request for excepted services:
 - Activities and operations requests #1-#25 are approved with the exception of requests #14 and #24. The following conditions apply to requests #1-#25:
 - Approval limited only for the duration of 1-21 October
 - Approval subject to recall
 - Marine Corps must provide cost estimates should any of the above requests incur new FY14 obligations over \$1 million.
 - Request #14 requires greater specificity, associated costs, timeframe, and any associated contract obligations/requirements.
 - Request #24 on-hold pending further legal review.
 - Activities and operations requests #26-#129 are approved with the following conditions:
 - Marine Corps must provide cost estimates should any of the above requests incur new FY14 obligations over \$1 million.

The specialized functions of Law Enforcement, Fire protection, Personnel and Physical Security, Monitoring alarm and control systems, Hazardous Waste Clean-Up (CBRNE), Anti-Terrorism require specialized training and certifications. Currently the plants are minimally staffed with rotating shifts to cover the 24 hour period with no backup capability without overtime authorization. Employee absence due to the emergency furlough would require overtime to avoid violations or fines. The lack of properly licensed, certified, and experienced plant operators for water and wastewater systems will result in legal/public relations issues.
