Subj: COMMAND RECRUITING PROGRAM

1. Situation. This Order promulgates instructions for the establishment of the Command Recruiting Program for Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, in accordance with the reference.

2. Cancellation. BO 1130.2B.

3. Mission. The reference establishes and provides instructions for the administration of the Command Recruiting Program. Command recruiting consists of any action taken by a commander to aid the recruiting service in attaining personnel goals. This action includes:

a. Authorization of up to 30 days Permissive Temporary Additional Duty (PTAD) will be at no expense to the government for Marines to assist in the recruiting effort in their hometowns.

b. Inform all Marines to the advantages of assisting in the recruiting effort while on leave, special liberty, or Permanent Change of Station (PCS)/Temporary Additional Duty (TAD) orders involving delay en route.

c. Counseling Marines on the benefits and incentives contained in enclosure (1) of the reference.

d. Summary of Revision. This Order has been revised and should be reviewed in its entirety.

4. Execution

a. Individual Marines who desire to participate in the PTAD portion of the Command Recruiting Program will submit their request to the appropriate recruiting station via the chain of command in accordance with enclosure (2) of the reference.

b. Commanding Officers will:

(1) Coordinate requests for PTAD with the commanding officer or the requested recruiting station to obtain concurrence.

(2) Evaluate each request received from a recruiting station on a case by case basis.

(3) Prepare PTAD Orders on personnel of their organization.

(4) Award Meritorious Promotions to the grades of Private First Class and Lance Corporal when appropriate in accordance with reference (b).

(5) Award Meritorious Masts or Certificates of Commendation in appropriate cases in accordance with reference (c).

(6) Upon receipt of appropriate documentation from the recruiting station, ensure that Lance Corporals and Corporals composite score bonus points are reported in the Marine Corps Total Force System (MCTFS).

(7) Provide the reporting senior of all Sergeants and above with reports of recruiter assistance so that appropriate comments may be made to their fitness reports.

(8) Submit Fleet Hometown News Releases (FHTNR) to the Consolidated Public Affairs Officer (CPAO), outlining the efforts of successful participants.

c. The Consolidated Public Affairs Officer will:

(1) Widely publicize the Command Recruiting Program on a continuing basis.

(2) Utilize FHTNR submissions to publicize the successful efforts of participants both locally and through the Fleet Hometown News Program.

5. Administration and Logistics. Not Applicable.

6. Command and Signal
