## COMMANDING GENERAL'S POLICY LETTER 15-19

Subj: COMMERCIAL VEHICLE INSPECTION POLICY EXCEPTION

Ref: (a) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 5530.25A

(b) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 3302.2 (FOUO)

(c) DoD Manual 5200.08 Volume 3 of 2 January 2019

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To better align the requirements regarding commercial vehicle inspections found in references (a) through (c).
- 2. <u>Information</u>. Currently, reference (a) requires all commercial vehicles entering the Installation undergo an inspection. This 100 percent inspection criteria is not a requirement per reference (b) authorizing random inspections. The current execution of 100 percent commercial vehicle inspections are delaying contractors entering the base and are excessive given this current threat condition.
- 3. Action. As an exception to current policy, the Commanding Officer (CO), Headquarters and Support Battalion (H&S Bn) is granted authority to randomly inspect commercial vehicles entering the Installation at Entry Control Facilities (ECF). The H&S Bn CO has discretion to increase or decrease the frequency of inspections to better manage the congestion at the ECFs as required. This policy letter will remain in effect until reference (a) is updated.
