#### Message from the Commanding General Marine Corps Installations East -Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune

As we transition from the longest period of conflict in our nation's history, in a climate of economic uncertainty, it has never been more challenging as a regional command to effectively support the operational forces and tenant commands. Our seven installations are vital to the training, readiness, and deployment of ground, logistics, and aviation forces worldwide. These installations support all branches of the military, their families, retirees, civilian employees, other government agencies, and contractors who greatly impact the economic health of our states and local communities.

During Fiscal Year 2013, our Marine Corps Installations East installations experienced significant fiscal constraints under the Continuing Resolution Authority, yet together they provided over \$9.7 billion dollars to the states of Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Virginia. The salaries and wages paid to active duty and retired military, and current and retired civilians, totaled more than \$5.6 billion dollars. These salaries contributed greatly to the economic well-being of the states and local communities who support each of these installations. Through construction contracts totaling over \$1 billion dollars, local area businesses, vendors, and contractors were bolstered economically through the purchase of materials, supplies, and services, adding additional revenue into these economies.

We treasure our relationships with state and local communities surrounding our installations and continue to be committed to their civic development and economic growth. We credit the success of the Marine Corps as our Nation's finest fighting force to our partnership with state and local communities. As economic conditions fluctuate, we shall remain steadfast on this path together; with the economic impact of Marine Corps Installations East installations to our state and local communities at the forefront.


