- 1. <u>Situation</u>. To ensure protection of the land and wildlife resources aboard Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCB CAMLEJ) and Marine Corps Air Station New River (MCAS NR) (collectively referred to as the "Installation"), this Order establishes policy and regulations as outlined in the references and the Installation's current hunting, fishing, and trapping environmental standard operating procedures (ESOP). The Installation's ESOP provides specific details of base procedures for hunting, fishing, trapping, boat launching, and firewood collection; and is located on the MCB CAMLEJ Conservation Law Enforcement's public website.
- 2. Cancellation. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 5090.115A.

#### 3. Mission

- a. This Order provides policy and procedures to ensure compliance with regulations and establishes responsibilities which govern hunting, trapping, scouting, dog training, firewood collection, fishing, and boat launching on the Installation, in an effort to provide conservation of land and wildlife resources.
- b. <u>Summary of Revision</u>. This Order and its associated ESOP have been revised in their entirety to comply with Federal and state regulations and laws, and should be thoroughly reviewed.

#### 4. Execution

- a. <u>Commander's Intent</u>. Hunting, fishing, and trapping shall be in compliance with this Order, associated ESOP, and all other applicable Federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
- b. <u>Concept of Operations</u>. This Order and associated ESOP fully adopt those regulations and procedures required in the implementation of Federal and state regulations and implements local applicable provisions relating to the recreational use identified herein. Annual bag limits and seasons shall be in compliance with Federal and state regulations, unless otherwise noted in current Installation ESOP.

## 5. Administration and Logistics

- a. This Order falls under the cognizance of the Commanding General (CG), Marine Corps Installations East-MCB CAMLEJ, and can be modified and waived as the CG deems necessary and appropriate to support requirements as they develop. Any significant recommended changes should be presented to the Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), G-F Department.
- b. The MCB CAMLEJ Conservation Law Enforcement Officer (CLEO) Section, Environmental Conservation Branch (ECON), Environmental Management Division (EMD), AC/S G-F is charged, through the section's immediate supervisor, with the enforcement of fish, wildlife, and natural resource conservation regulations and to request assistance and work effectively and harmoniously with state and Federal personnel. CLEOs shall enforce all regulations related to the directives, ESOP, and references of this Order. The MCB CAMLEJ CLEO and MCAS NR CLEO shall provide technical guidance to each other on enforcement and accident investigation as requested.
- c. The MCB CAMLEJ Land and Wildlife Resources Section, ECON, EMD, G-F is charged, through the section's immediate supervisor, to develop ESOPs for implementing a recreational program involving hunting, fishing, trapping, and boating; to determine when annual

changes to the ESOPs must be made to be in compliance with Federal and state regulations; and to make program level decisions to responsibly manage land and wildlife resources aboard the Installation.

- ECON is charged with administering the fish, game and non-game management programs aboard the Installation and to approve annual changes to the ESOP. Personnel notification of annual program changes will be distributed through all available and reasonable channels.
- Training. All personnel and civilian guests who wish to participate in hunting on the Installation must first satisfy all requirements concerning hunter safety competency prior to issuance of a MCB CAMLEJ hunting permit. - Punitive Effect. This Order's prohibitions, and conduct and procedures identified in the ESOP are punitive and those who violate this Order may be subject to adverse administrative or judicial action. Violations of this Order may be prosecuted under Article 92 of the Uniform Code of Military Justice or referred to the Special Assistant U.S. Attorney for prosecution in Federal court as appropriate. In addition, violations of this Order or the Installation's ESOP may result in the revocation of hunting, trapping, fishing, or other outdoor recreation privileges.

### 6. Command and Signal

- Command. This Order is applicable to MCB CAMLEJ, MCAS NR, and all subordinate and tenant commands aboard these installations.
