Subj: MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP LEJEUNE NON-TACTICAL VEHICLES TELEMATICS

POLICY GUIDANCE

Ref: (a) EO 14057

(b) DON Policy Memorandum 1-22

(c) MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 11240.1B

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. Per references (a) through (c), agencies will deploy telematics and collect and use fleet operational data to support a wide range of transportation needs, allowing commanders to enhance productivity, improve operational efficiency, and enforce positive driver behavior. Per reference (c), telematic devices are the property of GSA; devices which are found to be disconnected, damaged, stolen, lost, or tampered with will be reported for appropriate actions and applicable cost reimbursement.
- 2. <u>Information</u>. Effective immediately, telematics data reports will be provided on a bi-weekly basis to commands with custody of non-tactical vehicles (NTVs). Commanders will use this information to enforce the safe operation of NTVs and ensure driver accountability. This may include attendance in the 'Attitudinal Dynamics of Driving' course provided by the MCIEAST-MCB G-4 Safety Division, and unit or individual suspension of NTV use.
- 3. <u>Action</u>. This Policy is applicable to Marine Corps Base personnel assigned to Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune with assigned Motor Transport Division NTVs (GSA-lease or Agency-owned).
