1. Situation. To promulgate policy and instructions pertaining to the FAP in consonance with references (a) through (j).
2. Cancellation. II MEFO 5300.4C/MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 5300.4C.
3. Mission. This Order provides policy and guidance for the preparation, approval, and assignment of military members to the FAP.
4. Execution

a. Commanders Intent. To establish a program of mutual agreement whereby tenant commands agree to provide personnel to Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ) Installations for the purpose of providing personnel augmentation to compensate for the increased workload associated with supporting tenant commands and their families. Enclosure (1) contains FAP Policy and Procedural Guidance.

DISTRIBUTION STATEMENT A: Approved for public release, distribution is unlimited.

b. Concept of Operations. The FAP will be a coordinated effort between the Commander MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and tenant Commanders. Available personnel will be assigned to the FAP from tenant commands to MCIEAST installations to support the work requirements identified in enclosure (2).

5. Administration and Logistics. Directives issued by these Headquarters are published and distributed electronically on the following website: <https://www.mcieast.marines.mil/staff-offices/adjutant>.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ subordinate commands and installations, II Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF) Commands, U.S. Marine Corps Forces, Special Operations Command, Training and Education Command tenants, and all other non-operational and operational tenant commands located aboard MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations.

reference (i) will be managed separately from the FAP and are not included in the scope of this Order.

3. Policy

a. Mission Priority. The FAP should not alter the mission and functions of the installation, operational force commands or separate nonoperational tenant commands.

b. Readiness Consideration. Combat readiness and efficiency of the furnishing tenant unit is of primary importance and should be considered when validating and coordinating FAP issues. Parent commands must understand the relationship of the FAP as it relates to the support of their Marines, family members, retirees, contractors, and the local community. Severe reductions in FAP manning could have a diminished effect on support to operating forces (OPFOR) and non-OPFOR commands. If significant FAP vacancies occur, the respective installation FAP Coordinator, in conjunction with the cognizant staff office(s), will determine commensurate reduction in services/support to be provided. This information will be forwarded to the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), G-1 for review and further coordination with the II MEF, AC/S G-1 or other tenant commanders as appropriate. Sourcing determinations/resolution will be the responsibility of the AC/S, G-1, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and II MEF, AC/S, G-1, or Commander of the tenant organization. An annual FAP review will be conducted by the AC/S, G-1, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and AC/S, G-1, II MEF. Revalidation of authorized FAP billets and requests for changes (increases/decreases) will be considered at that time.

c. Recall. Personnel provided to MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations, via the FAP, will remain an integral part of their primary unit and will be available for recall if deployment is ordered at the major command level or higher. When a major OPFOR command deploys and retains an extensive rear element, FAP personnel will still be required by the installation proportionate to the level of support required by the rear elements. For the purposes of this order, deployment includes operational contingencies, major exercises (e.g., Weapons and Tactics Instructor's Course, Integrated Training Exercise, etc.), preparation for and execution of Marine Corps Combat Readiness Evaluation per reference (j), and the Unit Deployment Program.

d. FAP Termination Procedures

(1) A member having completed their prescribed FAP tour assignment, with a replacement onboard that has completed any required training will be returned to their parent command.

(2) Requests to terminate the FAP status for groups of personnel due to a unit deployment should be worked between the installation FAP coordinator and respective tenant command FAP coordinator. Should issues arise between the FAP Commander and tenant unit commander, the

units. Depending on its scope and immediacy, a recall can have little to severe impact on the host installation. To mitigate the impact, host installation commanders should establish and maintain plans that identify and provide for manning critical FAP billets when a recall does occur. Possible resources may include but are not limited to; Internal Resources/Reorganization, Temporary Service Contracts providing funding availability and employment of Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) personnel.

(5) Memorandums of Agreement/Memorandums of Understanding or local FAP agreements between II MEF Major Subordinate Commands or Elements and Installation Commanders without CG, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ or CG, II MEF review and approval are not authorized.

b. Review of Existing FAP Requirements and Procedures. An annual joint FAP validation/review will be initiated and chaired by the AC/S, G-1, MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and the AC/S G-1, II MEF. Changes resulting from this review will be submitted for consideration and approval as outlined above. Any emerging FAP requirements that require immediate sourcing should be staffed to the AC/S, G-1 MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ for validation and subsequent II MEF review/approval.

c. Personnel Welfare. Commanding Officers (COs) of MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations are responsible for the personal and professional welfare of supporting FAP Marines. COs of tenant units retain vested interest in their Marine's personal and professional growth of performance which should be monitored jointly. Coordination and cooperation between MCIEAST Installations and furnishing tenant units is essential. Installation commanders have identical responsibility for FAP personnel just as they do for their own permanent personnel.

d. Force Preservation Program. Personnel assigned to the Force Preservation Program as high risk are disqualified from assignment to the FAP. Personnel assigned low or medium risk may be assigned providing all other provisions of this Order are met. Personnel assigned to the FAP who are subsequently assigned to the Force Preservation Program as a high or medium risk will be assessed to determine continued eligibility of FAP assignment. Personnel found ineligible due to the Force Preservation assignment will be returned for replacement.

e. Conviction by Courts-Martial/Civil Court. A Marine must not have been convicted by courts-martial within six months prior to assignment, or under suspended sentence, as a result of courts-martial. The 1996 Lautenberg Amendment prohibits personnel convicted of a felony, domestic violence misdemeanor, or subject to a domestic violence protective order to ship, transport, possess or receive firearms or ammunition and will not be assigned to the FAP.

f. NJP. A Marine must not have been awarded NJP within three months prior to assignment or under suspended punishment as a result of NJP. The number of NJPs awarded to an individual does not constitute ineligibility. However, disciplinary trends such as unauthorized absence (UA) will constitute grounds for rejection if the offense occurred within a three-month period prior to assignment.

g. Derogatory Record. A Marine must not have received any derogatory administrative remarks in their service record book to include substandard performance of duty, not recommended for reenlistment, and termination for cause from a previous FAP tour within three months of their last assignment.

h. Disciplinary Action. Unit commanders will request the immediate termination of FAP personnel who are in a UA status, In Hands of Civilian Authorities, and In Hands of Military Authorities in excess of 10 working days or projected to exceed 10 working days. When termination orders are received, liaison with the respective parent command for personal effects disposition will be made.

i. JEPES Command Markings. A Marine must not have average Command Markings in service markings of less than 2.0, with no adjudication within the last 180 days. Acceptance of an individual with average markings of less than 2.0 may be made only in exceptional cases, as determined by prior concurrence of the Installation FAP Coordinator and the Supporting FAP Coordinator. All reporting occasions and marks must be reported and up to date in the systems of record prior to the FAP assignment.

j. Indebtedness/Substance Abuse. A Marine must have no history of failure to pay debts. In addition, a Marine must have no in service history of alcohol or drug abuse unless they have successfully completed an approved substance abuse program.

being armed in the execution of their duties and retained by the command. Both forms will be included with the member's FAP orders.

3. Special Assignment Prerequisites. Personnel assigned to the FAP must meet the specific billet prerequisites identified in enclosure (2).

4. FAP Review. A joint FAP review will be scheduled annually by the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ installations FAP coordinator and tenant FAP Coordinator's. The selected date for this review should allow for maximum participation by both installation and tenant FAP coordinators in addition to any subject matter experts from employing activities should detailed discussion be necessary to resolve support issues. Installation units and tenant organizations will review and validate FAP billet requirements and be prepared to discuss changes, additions, and deletions.

provide further instructions. Personnel must report with tenant unit FAP orders, FAP screening checklist and billet associated checklist(s). Personnel reporting without the required records will be returned to their parent command without an endorsement. The check-in period and billet turnover/training period should not be considered under the same time period, as each billet has specific turnover, training periods, and requirements.

5. Transportation. Parent commands are responsible for furnishing transport to the installation FAP coordinator. Upon FAP termination, the installation unit is responsible for return transportation to the member's parent command.

6. Entitlements

a. Housing. A member assigned to FAP who resides in the Bachelor Enlisted Quarters or Bachelor Officer Quarters at their parent command would normally relocate to a barracks room managed by the FAP command, at no cost to the government. A married member in receipt of Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) at the with-dependent rate will not have their entitlement changed without coordination with the member's parent command. Members authorized BAH at the without-dependent rate will not have their entitlement changed without coordination with the member's parent command. Situations that require a BAH change in order to maintain good order and discipline will be coordinated between the FAP unit commander and the member's parent command.

b. Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) Monthly. BAS-Monthly current allowance should not change to a lower amount due to assignment to a FAP requirement. If requirements dictate a change in BAS-Monthly entitlement an adjustment is authorized while in a FAP status. Upon return to their parent command their BAS-Monthly will be reestablished to the rate paid prior to assignment to FAP.

c. Special Pay. A Marine's entitlement to special pays will continue while in a FAP status providing adherence to all special pay requirements are met while assigned FAP.

7. Personnel Reporting

a. Commencement and termination of FAP will be reported into the Marine Corps Total Force System (MCTFS) by the installation RPAC. FAP coordinators will ensure internal controls are established to monitor and manage MCTFS reporting for accountability purposes.

b. Parent commands will carry FAP Marines in a FAP status on the Unit Management Strength Report (USMR) within Marine On-Line (MOL). MOL USMR will be updated to track duty status changes and updates such as leave, sick, etc.

c. Commanding Officers of MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installations are responsible to account for Marines attached to their commands in a FAP

necessary for promotion eligibility have been completed prior to assignment to the FAP.

c. Officer and Staff Noncommissioned Officer (SNCO). Officer and SNCO promotion certificates will be forwarded to the installation unit unless the individual desires presentation by the parent command.

d. Meritorious Promotion. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installation commands will utilize meritorious promotion quotas assigned to them to meritoriously promote FAP personnel.

10. Organization Property/Special Clothing and Equipment

a. Organizational Property. All organizational property will be recovered prior to assigning personnel to the FAP.

b. Special Clothing and Equipment. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ units will issue any special clothing/equipment items necessary for the FAP billet assignment. This clothing/equipment will be recovered from the Marine prior to FAP termination. An exception to this policy is for the Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting (ARFF) section. Marines who are assigned FAP to ARFF will report/check-in with all required firefighting Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) issued by their parent command. ARFF Marines terminated from the FAP will be returned to their parent units with serviceable firefighting PPE.

11. Training

a. CAT I. CAT I FAP personnel will be provided annual training by the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Installation FAP command.

b. CAT II. CAT II FAP personnel assigned to a billet for greater than nine months will be afforded an opportunity by the Installation FAP command to complete annual training requirements.

c. CAT III. CAT III FAP assignments should have completed annual training prior to assignment. Every effort will be made by the supporting command to ensure that CAT II and CAT III FAP personnel are trained prior to assignment. Acceptance of personnel with missing annual training will be coordinated between the installation and tenant FAP coordinators.

12. Leave and Liberty

a. Approval Authority. The approval authority for granting of leave and liberty to FAP personnel is the responsibility of the FAP unit commander to which assigned. Unless previously coordinated with the installation FAP coordinator, personnel reporting for FAP with pre-approved leave authorization(s) by the supporting command will be disqualified for FAP assignment.

c. CAT III. CAT III personnel are not typically authorized TAD while FAP and will be considered on a case-by-case basis dependent upon the individual requirement.

14. Discipline

a. Jurisdiction. The installation FAP unit commander will assume responsibility for investigating Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) offenses allegedly committed by FAP personnel and take the required disciplinary action, if warranted. It is recommended that the FAP unit commander brief the supporting unit commander prior to initiating any disciplinary action.

b. UA. In UA cases, the installation FAP coordinator will immediately be notified by the installation unit commander. On the absentee's 10th day of absence, replacement proceedings will be initiated in order to have a replacement on deck prior to the 20th day of UA. The installation unit will immediately terminate the absentee's FAP on the 10th day of UA. FAP assignment will be terminated and delivered to the individual's parent command and appropriate unit RPAC. Requirements for any administrative reporting and actions fall upon the FAP Unit Commander until termination of FAP occurs. Parent commands will process the required documents to drop a Marine to desertion to include preparation of the DD Form 553.

c. UCMJ/Courts-Martial. Supported unit commanders assume the responsibility for action regarding minor offenses under the UCMJ committed by FAP personnel, where offenses would normally be referred to NJP or trial by summary courts-martial. Exceptions will be coordinated between the unit commanders and the parent unit commander. In cases where the installation unit commander deems trial by special or general courts-martial is appropriate, immediate steps will be taken to terminate the FAP and return personnel to their parent command. Upon termination of the FAP the supporting command should initiate actions to identify and provide a replacement. All associated documents and evidence will be hand carried to the Marine's parent command for action as deemed appropriate. Exceptions will be coordinated between the Installation FAP Coordinator and tenant command FAP Coordinator. Commanders may request termination of FAP for personnel awarded NJP or convicted by a civil court when the adjudicated legal action disqualifies them for FAP assignment in accordance with this Order. Requests for termination will be referred to the installation FAP coordinator for determination.

d. Termination for Other than Disciplinary Reasons. Personnel assigned to the FAP must maintain a positive general attitude and not display any pattern of substandard performance or unacceptable conduct during their FAP assignment. Personnel who have unresolved Family Advocacy issues are ineligible for FAP assignment. Personnel who incur Family Advocacy issues while assigned FAP will be assessed to determine the level of treatment required. Personnel that are unable to fulfill

a. Death. In the case of the death of a Marine or Sailor assigned to the FAP, casualty procedures will be followed in accordance with references (g). FAP unit commander will ensure notification of member's parent command.

b. Very Serious/Serious Injury/Illness or Incapacitation. Upon notification or occurrence of a very serious/serious injury/illness or incapacitation of a Marine or Sailor assigned to the FAP, procedures will be followed in accordance with references (g).

c. Hospitalization. Personnel hospitalized for other than very serious/serious injury/illness or incapacitation, while assigned to the FAP, will remain in a FAP status provided the hospitalization (including recuperation, convalescent leave, or sick in quarters) does not exceed 10 consecutive days. Otherwise, the FAP unit will process the individual's FAP status on the 11th day of hospitalization, then notify the supporting command via the installation FAP coordinator.

d. Replacements. Installation FAP units will notify the appropriate FAP coordinator on the first working day subsequent to the death, very serious/serious injury/illness, incapacitation, or excess hospitalization period to initiate replacement proceedings. The installation FAP coordinators will notify the tenant FAP coordinator to discuss further actions regarding replacements.

19. Tour Extensions

a. Requests. Personnel may be extended on the FAP for as many months as considered mutually beneficial as concurred upon by both the installation command and tenant command. Extensions which allow for a tour length in excess of 12 months are not normally considered mutually beneficial unless the individual is assigned within their primary MOS or are within 180 days from separating from service. Requests for tour length extension must be forwarded in writing to the individual's parent command via the appropriate FAP coordinator, not less than 30 days prior to the normal rotation tour date. Enclosure (6) will be utilized to request FAP extensions. This request form can be signed electronically and will be forwarded via e-mail.

b. Final Action. Final decisions on all requests for tour extensions rest with the member's parent command or FAP unit coordinator. If approved, parent commands must provide the member with an orders modification for the duration of the tour extension.

20. Tour Termination

a. Liaison. For continuity and coordination, installation FAP coordinators serve as the primary liaison with the tenant command FAP coordinator in all cases involving termination or replacement. The installation FAP coordinator will notify the tenant FAP coordinator upon occasion of termination. Enclosure (6) will be utilized to

coordinator must notify the tenant command FAP coordinator to arrange for a replacement.

(4) Individuals reenlisting, who are entitled to SRB payment and desire to remain on the FAP after reenlistment, may not be assigned to a billet outside their primary MOS, unless a waiver of MOS restriction is obtained. It is the responsibility of the Installation unit to initiate a waiver request. If a waiver is denied, the individual will be terminated from the FAP and returned to the parent command immediately following reenlistment.

(5) Individuals awarded NJP or convicted by civil court may be terminated from the FAP. Determination to terminate such individuals will be based upon the circumstances of the case. For example: An individual awarded NJP for petty larceny could not reasonably remain on the FAP in a billet requiring public trust; i.e., a billet requiring accountability for government funds.

(6) An individual assigned to the FAP who has been identified by a positive urinalysis test sample or is otherwise involved in a documented drug related incident, will be immediately terminated from FAP, and returned to their parent command. Assignment of replacement personnel should be expedited under these circumstances.

(7) With the concurrence of the tenant FAP coordinator, personnel may be terminated for good and sufficient reasons. This pertains to personnel who after 30 days of observation are not qualified for the FAP billet to which assigned. Examples of this might be: an individual's inability to complete a range coach course; an inability to project as an instructor; or inability to pass the open water course. The installation FAP Coordinator will be notified in each case. If mutual consent cannot be reached between the installation FAP coordinator and the member's tenant FAP coordinator regarding termination, the FAP command will provide written justification to the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ installation FAP coordinator for coordination with the AC/S, G-1, or separate tenant commander for final decision. Termination will not constitute a bar from reassignment to another FAP billet if the parent command approves.

(8) Marines will be terminated as soon as possible when requested by the parent commander via the tenant FAP coordinator for good and sufficient reasons. Such requests will be addressed to the installation FAP coordinator and include provisions for replacement.

(9) Individuals hospitalized in excess of 10 days will be terminated on the 11th day of hospitalization.

d. Check-Out. All FAP personnel being terminated will be allotted check-out time at the Installation unit level not to exceed three working days. When check-out is completed, FAP personnel will be directed to report to the installation FAP coordinator for issuance of a FAP termination endorsement.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

AUTHORITY: 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(9); E.O. 9397.

PRINCIPAL PURPOSE(S): To obtain information to determine if you have been convicted of a crime of domestic violence which would disqualify you from shipping, transporting, possessing or receiving either Government-issued or private firearms or ammunition and to determine if reassignment, reclassification, detail or other administrative action is warranted. Your Social Security Number is solicited solely for purposes of verifying your identity.

ROUTINE USE(S): To the Department of Justice so that such information can be included in the National Instant Criminal Background Check System which may be used by firearm licensees (importers, manufacturers or dealers) to determine whether individuals are qualified to receive or possess firearms and ammunition.

DISCLOSURE: Mandatory for all personnel who are required to certify. Failure to provide the information may result in (1) (military only) the imposition of criminal or administrative penalties for failing to obey a lawful order, and (2) (civilian only) the imposition of administrative penalties, to include removal from Federal service. However, neither your answers nor information or evidence gained by reason of your answers can be used against you in any criminal prosecution for a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(9), including (military only) prosecutions under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, based on a violation of Section 922(g)(9), for conduct which occurred prior to the completion of this form. The answers you furnish and any information resulting therefrom, however, may be used against you in a criminal or administrative proceedings if you knowingly and willfully provide false statements or information.

SECTION I - INSTRUCTIONS

An amendment to the Gun Control Act of 1968 (18 U.S.C. 922) makes it a felony for anyone who has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to ship, transport, possess, or receive firearms or ammunition. It is also a felony for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of a firearm to any person so convicted.

The Department of Defense has, by policy, expanded the prohibitions contained in Title 18 Section 922(g)(9) to those military or civilian personnel who have felony convictions for crimes of domestic violence. Convictions of crimes of domestic violence do not include summary court-martial convictions, the imposition of nonjudicial punishment (Article 15, UCMJ), or deferred prosecutions (or similar alternative dispositions) in civilian courts. Furthermore, a person shall not be considered as having committed a "crime of domestic violence" for purposes of the firearms restriction of the Gun Control Act unless all of the following elements are present:

- (1) the person was convicted of a crime;
- (2) the offense has as its factual basis the use or attempted use of physical force, or threatened use of a deadly weapon;
- (3) the convicted offender was at the time of the offense:
 - (a) a current or former spouse, parent or guardian of the victim,
 - (b) a person with whom the victim shared a child in common,

- (c) a person who was cohabiting with or has cohabited with the victim as a spouse, parent, or guardian, or
- (d) a person who was similarly situated to a spouse, parent, or guardian of the victim;

(4) the convicted offender was represented by counsel, or knowingly and intelligently waived the right to counsel;

(5) if entitled to have the case tried by jury, the case was actually tried by jury or the person knowingly and intelligently waived the right to have the case tried by jury;

(6) the conviction has not been expunged or set aside, or the convicted offender has not been pardoned for the offense or had civil rights restored, unless the pardon, expungement, or restoration of civil rights provides that the person may not ship, transport, possess or receive firearms.

If you have ever received a domestic violence conviction: (1) you may not possess any firearm or ammunition; and (2) you must return any Government-issued firearm or ammunition to your commander or immediate supervisor; and (3) you must take steps to relinquish possession of any privately owned firearms or ammunition. Furthermore, any previously issued authorization to possess a firearm or ammunition is revoked.

If you have any questions, or you are uncertain if you have such a conviction, you may wish to contact a legal assistance attorney, if eligible, or a private attorney, at your own expense.

1. Inherent Right of Self Defense. Unit commanders always retain the inherent right and obligation to exercise unit self-defense in response to a hostile act or demonstrated hostile intent. Unless otherwise directed by a unit commander as detailed below, I may:

a. _____ Exercise individual self-defense in response to a hostile act or demonstrated hostile intent.

b. _____ However, I understand that when I am assigned and acting as part of a unit, my individual self-defense should be considered a subset of unit-self defense. As such, my unit commander may limit my individual inherent right of self-defense.

2. De-Escalation and the Use of Non-Deadly Force. I understand that:

a. _____ When time and circumstances permit, the threatening force should be warned and given the opportunity to withdraw or cease threatening actions.

b. _____ Normally, force is to be used only as a last resort, and the force used should be the minimum necessary. The use of force must be reasonable to counter the threat. If force is required, non-deadly force is authorized and may be used to control a situation and accomplish the mission, or to provide self-defense of DOD forces, defense of non-DOD persons in the vicinity if directly related to the assigned mission, or in defense of the protected property, when doing so is reasonable under the circumstances.

3. The Use of Deadly Force. Deadly force is to be used only when all lesser means have failed or cannot reasonably be employed. Deadly force is authorized under the following circumstances:

a. _____ When there is reasonable belief that a person(s) poses an imminent threat of death or serious bodily harm to DOD persons. Self-defense includes defense of other DOD persons in the vicinity.

b. ____ In defense of non-DOD persons in the vicinity, when directly related to the assigned mission.

c. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears to be necessary to prevent the actual theft or sabotage of properly designated assets vital to national security.

d. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears to be necessary to prevent the actual theft or sabotage of inherently dangerous property (i.e., explosives, weapons ammunition, etc.).

e. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears to be necessary to prevent the sabotage of national critical infrastructure.

For the purposes of DOD operations, "national critical infrastructure" is defined as President-designated public utilities, or similar critical infrastructure, vital to public health or safety, the damage to which the President determines would create an imminent threat of death or serious bodily harm.

4. Additionally, when directly related to the assigned mission, deadly force is authorized under the following circumstances:

a. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears to be necessary to prevent the commission of a serious offense that involves imminent threat of death or serious bodily harm (for example, setting fire to an inhabited dwelling or sniping), including the defense of other persons, where deadly force is directed against the person threatening to commit the offense. Examples include murder, armed robbery, and aggravated assault.

b. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears to be necessary to prevent the escape of a prisoner, provided there is probable cause to believe that such person(s) have committed or attempted to commit a serious offense, that is, one that involves imminent threat of death or serious bodily harm, and would pose an imminent threat of death or serious bodily harm to DOD forces or others in the vicinity.

c. ____ When deadly force reasonably appears necessary to arrest or apprehend a person who, there is probable cause to believe, has committed a serious offense (as indicated in paragraph 3, above).

5. Additional Specific Instructions:

a. ____ I am prohibited from firing warning shots.

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b. ____ I will remove my pistol from my holster only when:

(1) The use of deadly force is imminent, or to affect the apprehension of a suspect I believe to be armed or dangerous, or to gain control of a dangerous situation.

(2) Ordered to do so by competent authority.

(3) Returning it to storage.

(4) Cleaning it in an authorized area.

c. ____ I will show due regard for the safety of innocent bystanders when using force.

6. ____ I will not point any firearm at any person, except:

a. ____ To gain control of a situation.

b. ____ When I intend to use deadly force.

c. ____ During on-duty reaction drill, only after I have checked the firearm and it has also been checked by my supervisor to ensure no rounds are in the weapon.

7. ____ If I chamber a round in a rifle or shotgun, or remove my pistol from its holster, proper notifications will be made and a Statement of Force form will be completed.

8. ____ When clearing a firearm, I will follow current policies and procedures pertaining to firearms handling, clearing, and safety.

a. No weapon will be cleared without a supervisor (Marine Sergeant and MCCLEP GS-09 or above) present and clearing will be accomplished only in the designated area (i.e., clearing barrel).

b. When drawing a weapon from the armory/arms room, rounds will be drawn after ensuring the weapon is clear.

c. When returning a weapon to the armory/arms room, rounds will always be properly accounted for and turned in prior to clearing the weapon, unless a round has been chambered.

d. I will report any violation of these policies or procedures immediately to the proper authority.

9. ____ I am prohibited from using a privately owned firearm or ammunition on duty.

10. ____ During training exercises and testing, I will check my firearm and have it double checked by another person, to ensure that no live rounds are in the weapon and that there is no magazine inserted in the weapon.

11. ____ I will comply with these principles when using non-lethal weapons or techniques in such a manner that could cause death or serious bodily harm.

12. Acknowledgement. I have been instructed on the use of deadly force and acknowledge that I understand and will comply with the basic rules for the use of force and weapons safety. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the basic rules for the use of force and weapons safety may result in administrative, disciplinary, and/or criminal penalties.
