1. Situation. To conserve and protect wildlife resources on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCB CAMLEJ) and Marine Corps Air Station New River (MCAS NR) (collectively referred to as the "Installation"), this Order establishes policy and procedures for the development, operation, and maintenance of regulated public outdoor recreation, including hunting, trapping, firewood collection, fishing, and boat launching, on the Installation. Reference (a) publishes policy and procedures for conducting regulated public outdoor recreation activities on the Installation.

2. Cancellation. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJO 5090.115B.

3. Mission

a. Mission. As implemented by reference (a), publish policy and procedures to ensure compliance with references (a) through (e). The policies and procedures apply to regulated public outdoor recreation activities on the Installation.

b. Summary of Revision. This Order and its associated Environmental Standard Operating Procedures (ESOP) have been revised in their entirety and should be thoroughly reviewed.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations.

(1) Commander's Intent. To sustain and enhance military use of the Installation, regulated public outdoor recreation activities on the Installation shall comply with this Order and its associated ESOP, and all other applicable federal, state, and local natural resources management requirements.

(2) Concept of Operations. Specific tasks and responsibilities for implementing this Order and reference (a) are published below.

b. Tasks

(1) Assistant Chief of Staff (AC/S), G-F. The AC/S G-F shall serve as the MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ principal staff lead for conserving and protecting wildlife resources on MCB CAMLEJ and shall oversee, coordinate, and direct staff action to comply with this Order and its associated ESOP, and all other applicable federal, state, and local natural resources management requirements.

(2) Commanding Officer, MCAS NR. To promote the safety, well-being, and efficiency of MCAS NR, the Commanding Officer, MCAS NR, shall implement reference (a); execute reference (c), Volume 11, paragraph 0403, responsibilities pertaining to natural resources management on MCAS NR; and coordinate MCAS NR natural resources management activities with the AC/S G-F staff.

5. Administration and Logistics

a. Administration. Reference (a), the "Environmental Standard Operating Procedures (ESOP) for Regulated Public Outdoor Recreation, Including Hunting, Fishing, and Trapping on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and Marine Corps Air Station New River, is found in the Installation Environmental Management System found at <https://www.lejeune.marines.mil/Offices-Staff/Conservation-Law-Enforcement/>.

b. Logistics. Not applicable.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ and its subordinate commands and staff sections on the Installation. It is also applicable to Installation tenant organizations, and other individuals on the Installation participating in regulated public outdoor recreation activities.
